

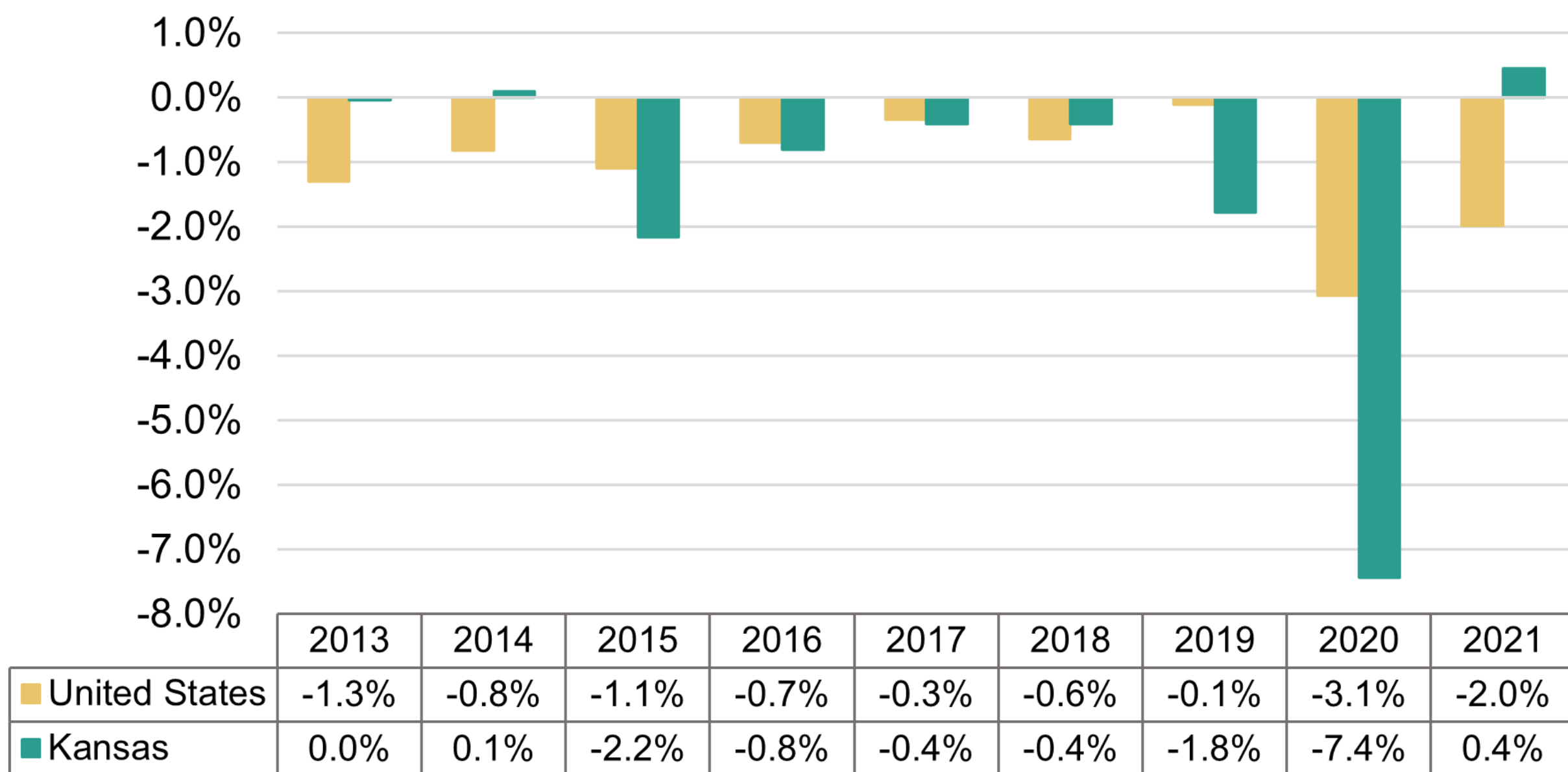

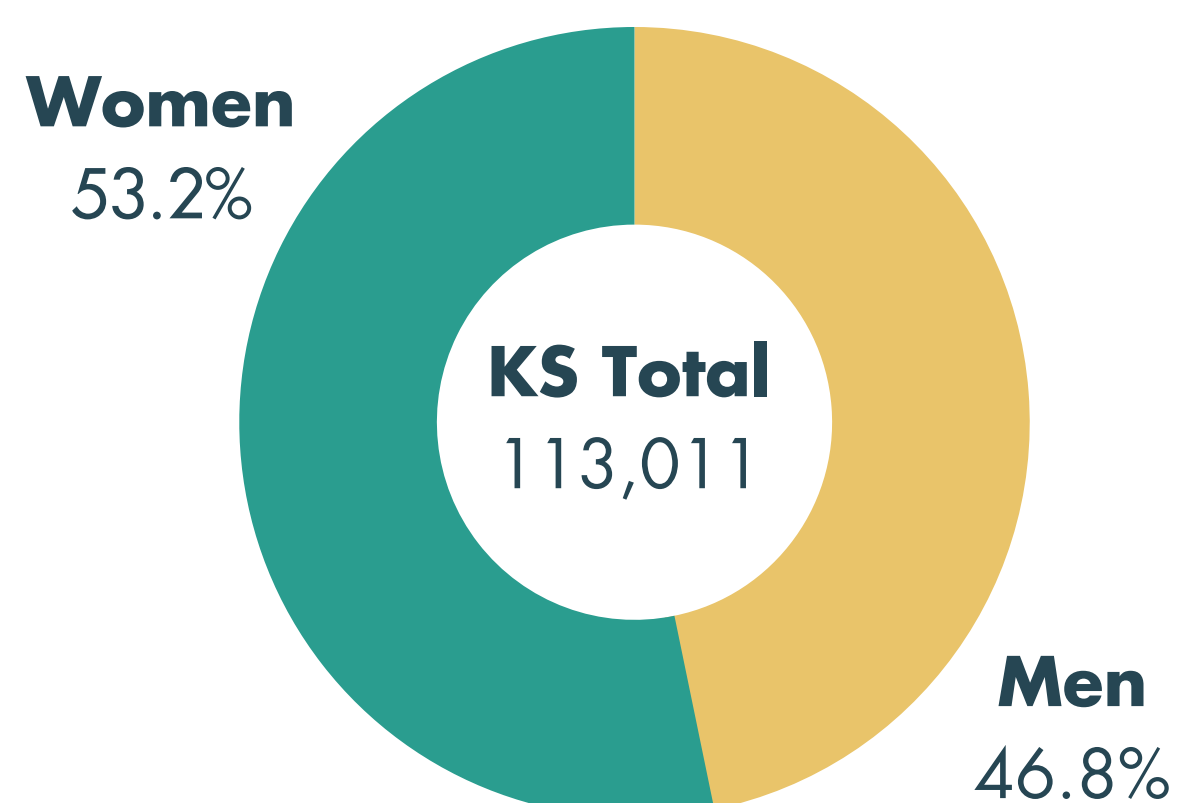
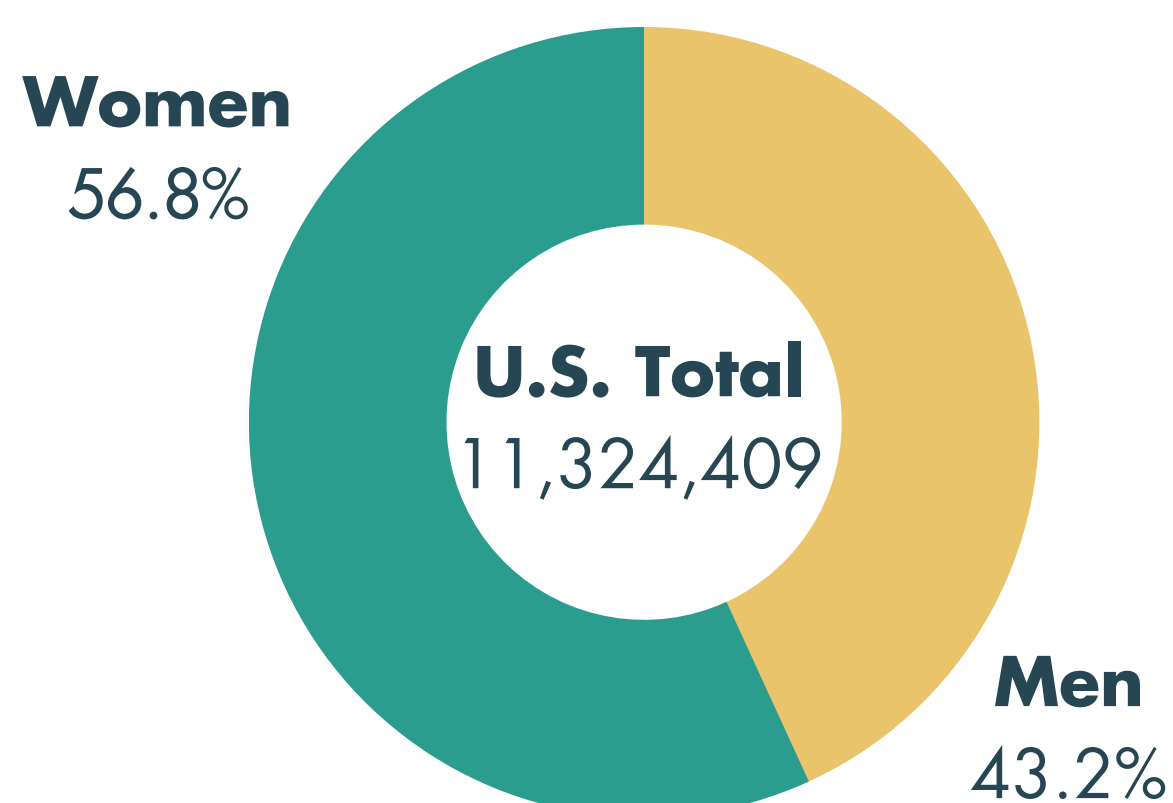
Percent Change in Total Enrollment

2013 - 2021



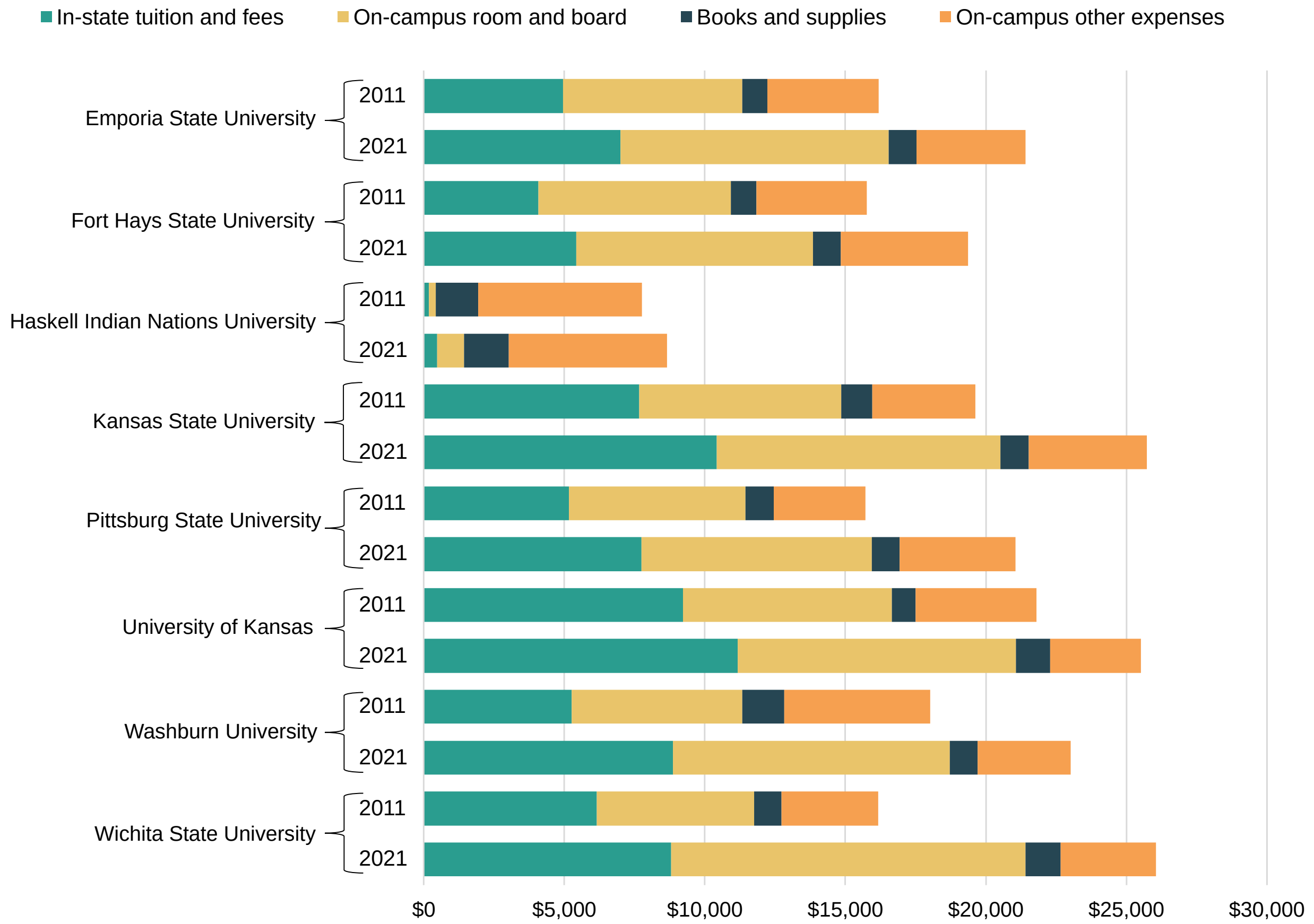
Full Time Enrollment by Gender

Fall 2021



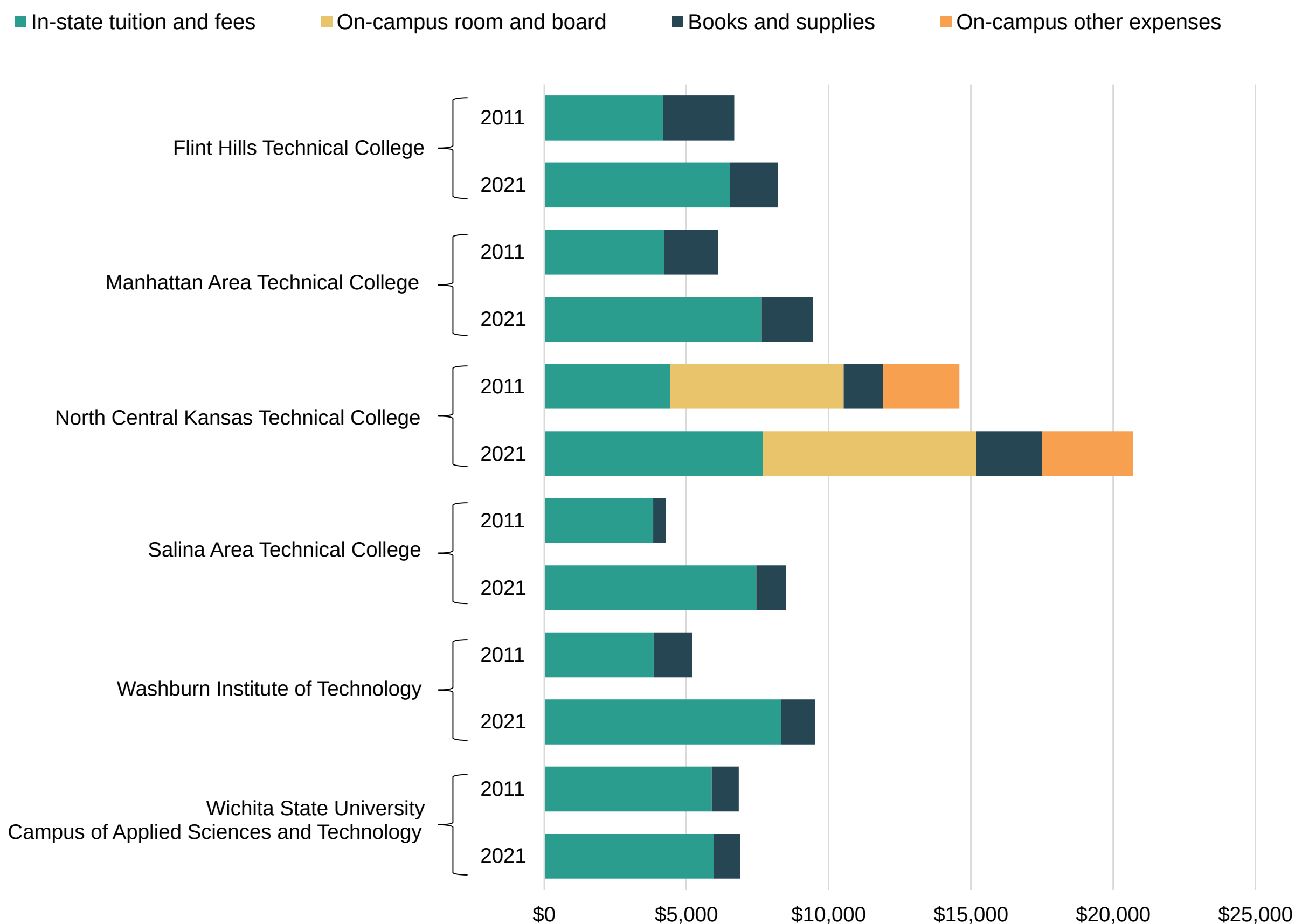
On Campus In-State Price Trends

Public 4-year Institutions 2011 and 2021

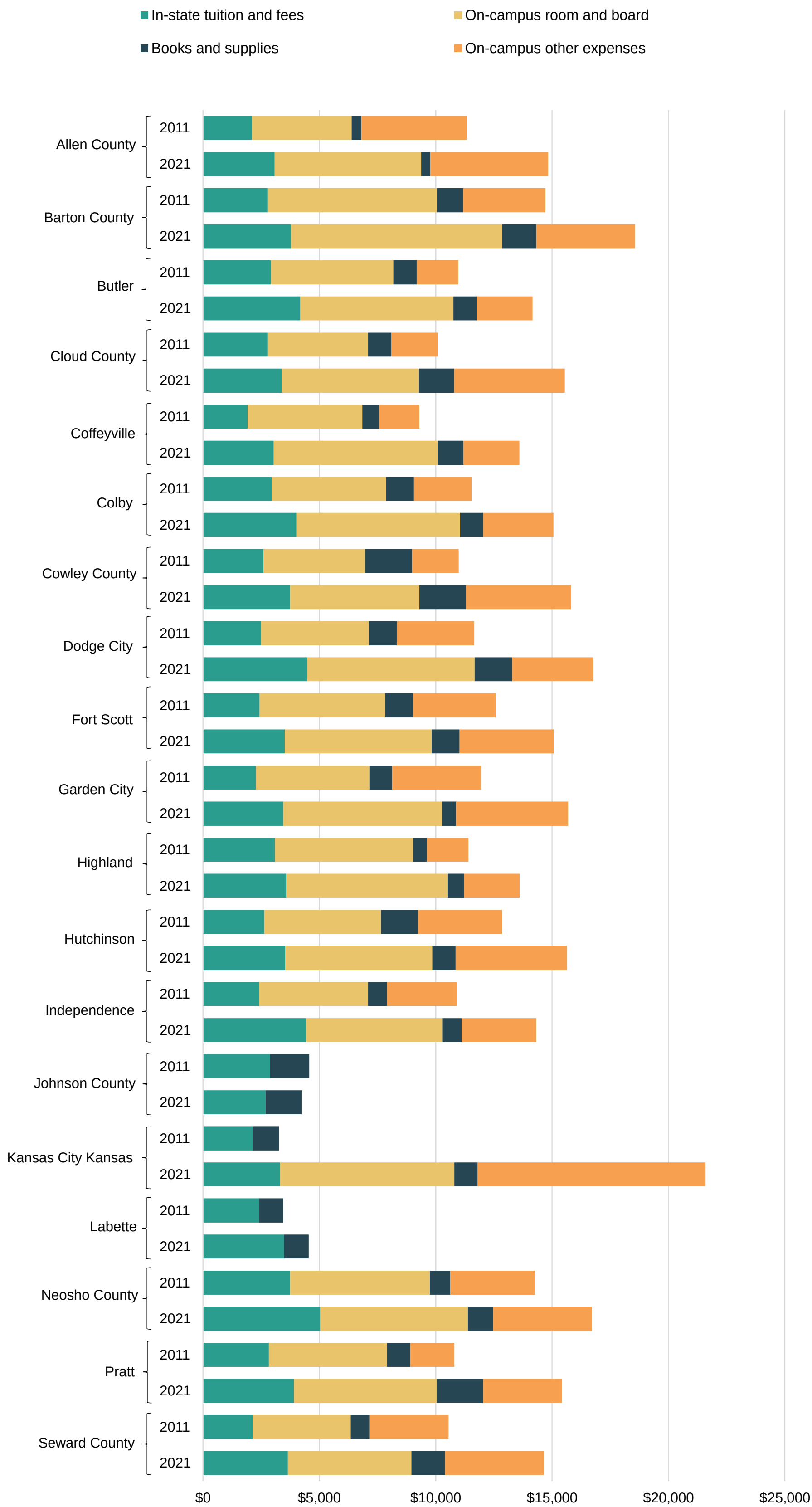

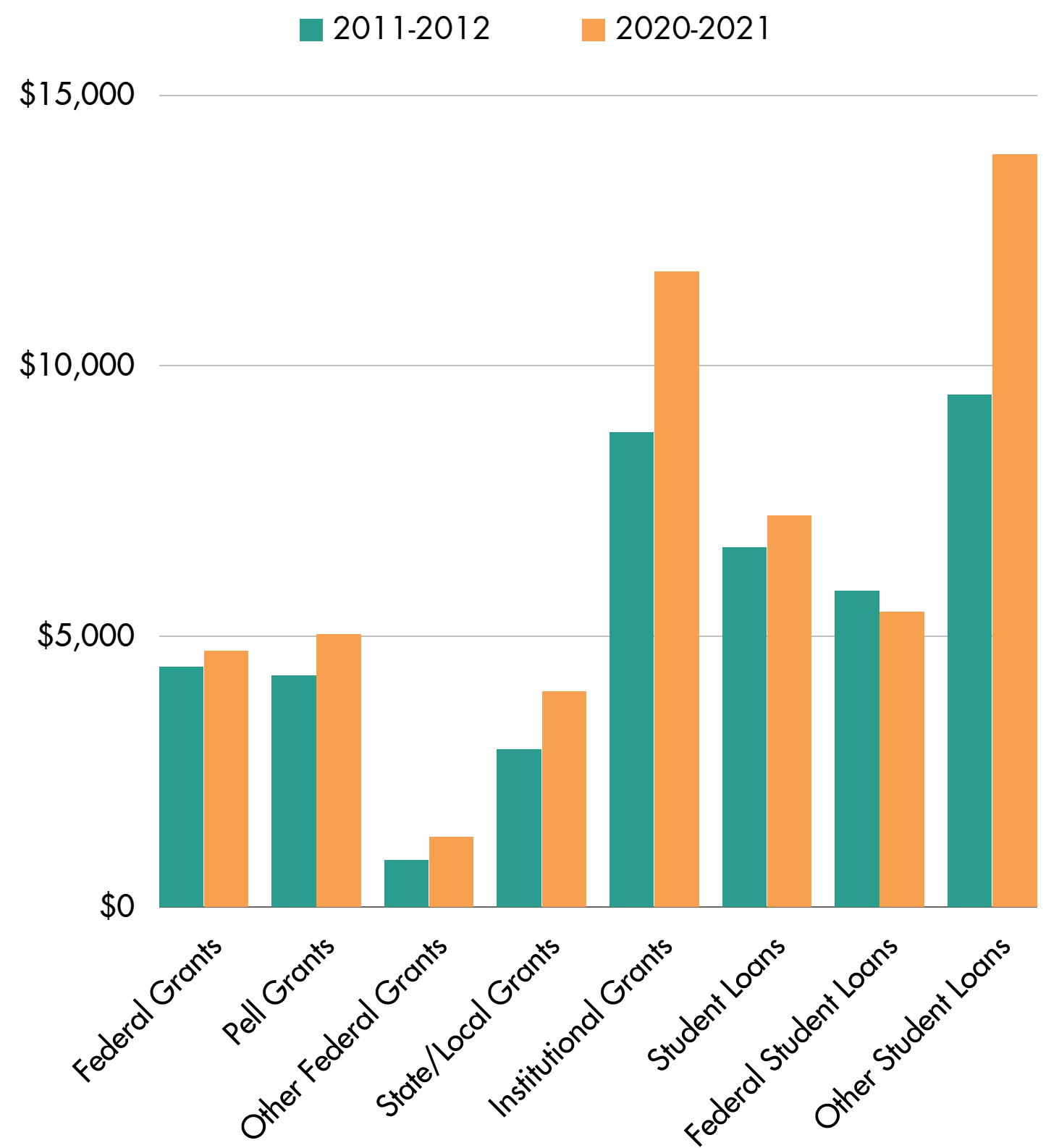
Public 2-year or Less Technical Colleges 2011 and 2021



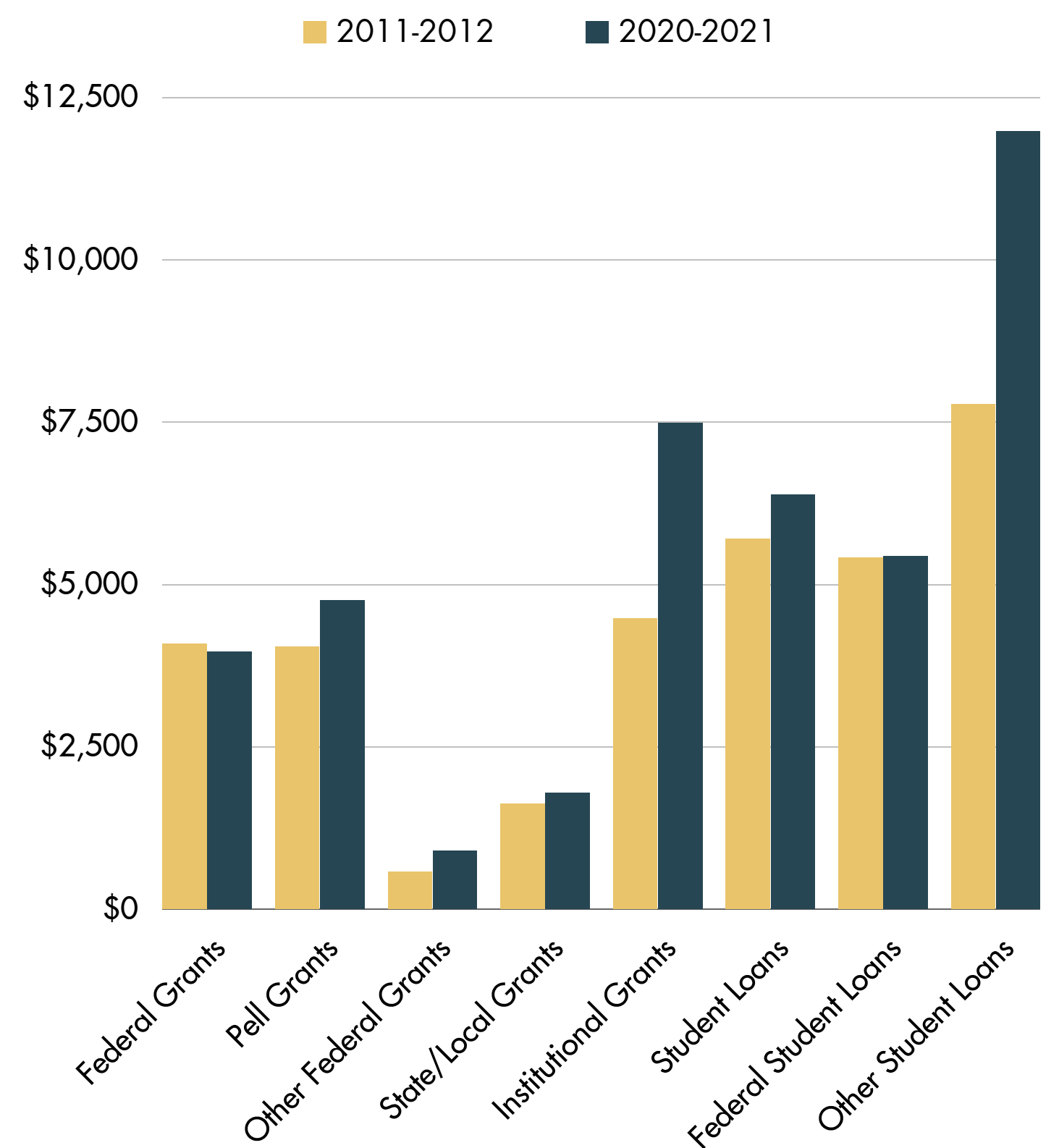
On Campus In-State Price Trends Public 2-year or Less Community Colleges 2011 and 2021
